Indigenous Workstars has been selected to support Indigenous Jobseekers through the new Workforce Australia model from 4 July 2022.

Indigenous Workstars are proud to partner with CoAct to deliver employment support through the Australian Government's new Workforce Australia program in the Fitzroy Region. Our Indigenous Specialist Organisation service locations will be in Rockhampton, Gladstone and Woorabinda.

Indigenous Workstars particularly supports the integrated training, mentoring and support systems being built into the new model.

The Australian Government is transforming the way employment services are being delivered nationally through the introduction of its new employment service, Workforce Australia from July this year.

The new model was informed by extensive collaboration with over 1400 stakeholders and included user-centred design with job seekers, employers and employment service providers.

Workforce Australia Services will provide upfront, early investment in an intensive, individually tailored, case management service for individuals assessed as being at risk of becoming long-term unemployed and having vocational or non-vocational barriers to work.

The Workforce Australia model centres on helping Australians to find and keep a job, change jobs or create their own job and connecting employers with jobseekers. The services aim to equip Australians with the skills, training and resources they need to gain sustainable and satisfying employment in a more modern and flexible approach.
